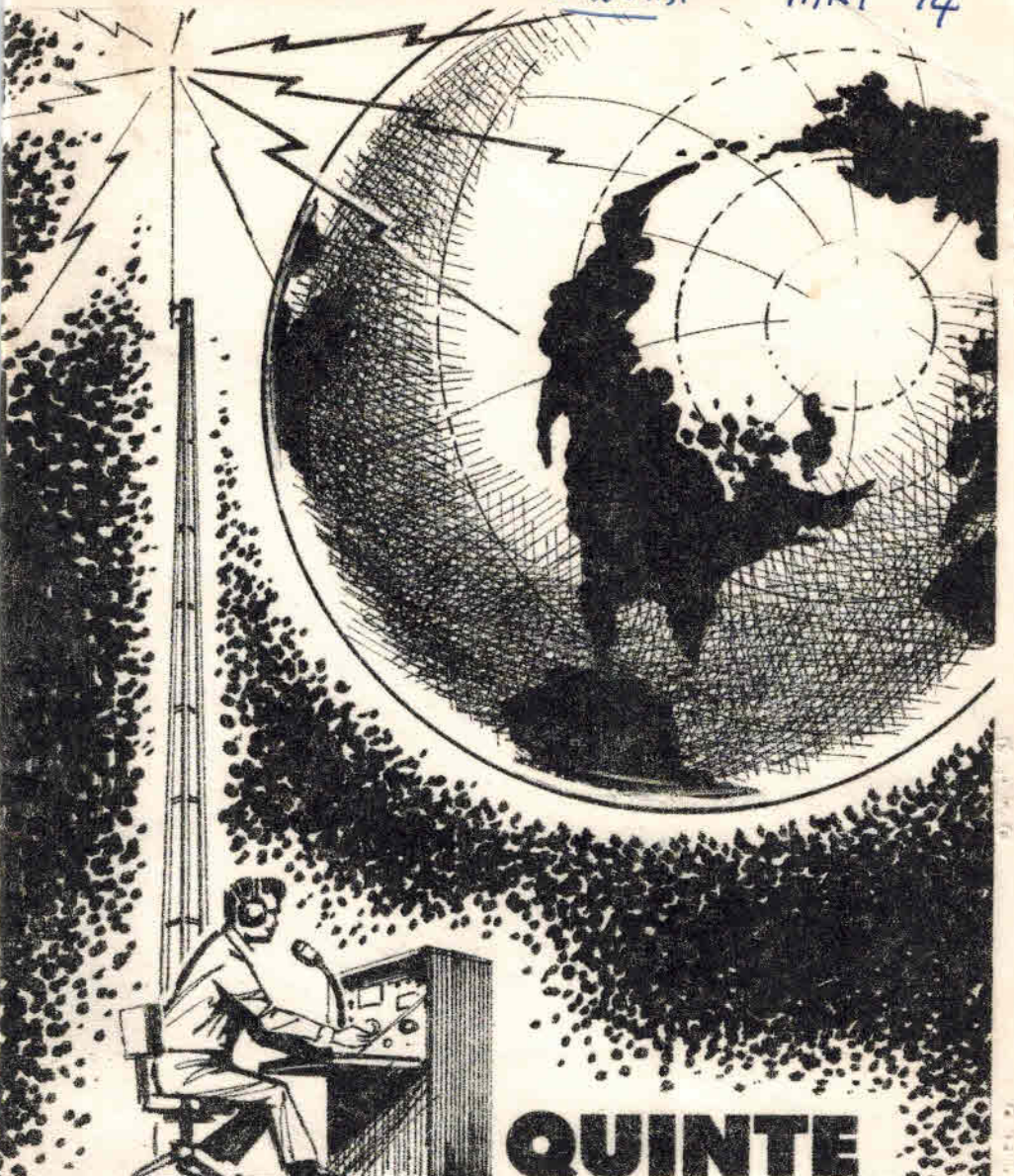

When you read this, the Ottawa and Mt. St. Patrick repeaters will have switched input frequencies. This change just about completes the standardization of all repeaters in Southern Ontario. Briefly, here is how things now stand:

Belleville, Toronto, Mt. St. Patrick, Montreal 146.46 - 147.06

Peterboro, Kingston, Ottawa 146.34 - 146.94

USA & Canada calling & ragchew 146.52

Local monitor VE3KBR (46-06)

Belleville ragchew 146.58 - 146.58 (when 52-52 in use)

Most popular in USA 146.34 - 146.94
146.28 - 146.88

Brockville (proposed) 146.37 - 146.97

Kitchener 146.37 - 146.97

Since 94 is a repeater output (3 repeaters in Belleville range), this frequency should be avoided for local simplex use. The only fly in the ointment now is the excessive power used by Toronto. If we can get them to reduce it to a reasonable level, the last snag in the Ontario repeater system will be eliminated.

10 meters is starting to show signs of coming to life. Openings are quite frequent during daylight hours. 20 meters is not very good of late. Late evening DX on 80 is quite good. If you haven't got a beam try a vertical on 10 it's a simple antenna that seems to do a good job on this band.

Anybody for fast scan TV? Bill, VE3COK, and Howard, VE3RL, are thinking seriously about it!!
