The ZOOM invitations will be emailed the day of the meeting(s).



Minutes of QARC Meeting - April 21, 2025

Club president Dave Ackerman VE3OX brought the meeting to order. Dave welcomed guests and members.

A moment of silence was observed for **Joe Thibedeau VE3LVT** who passed away on March 18, 2025 at the age of 98 and **Ian MacFarquhar VE9IM** former RAC Vice President who passed away on April 8, 2025.

Repeater Updates

The new VE3QAR frequency of **146.865** MHz with 91.5 Hz ctcss tone access has not totally resolved our intermod issues. Testing using a DCS code and split ctcss tones resulted in the split tone set up providing a better result to resolve our problem. On April 24, the repeater configuration was changed to a **91.5** Hz ctcss tone on the input and a **118.8** Hz tone on the output. This seems to have significantly improved the issue with only a slight echo effect observed from time to time.

For those wondering this configuration will remain in effect for the forseeable future. There are no plans to switch back to the old frequency of 146.985 MHz.

On the UHF side, the VE3BEL repeater 444.475 MHz (+) is operational in C4FM WIRES-X mode. Node ID: 30589 - Room ID: 40589
