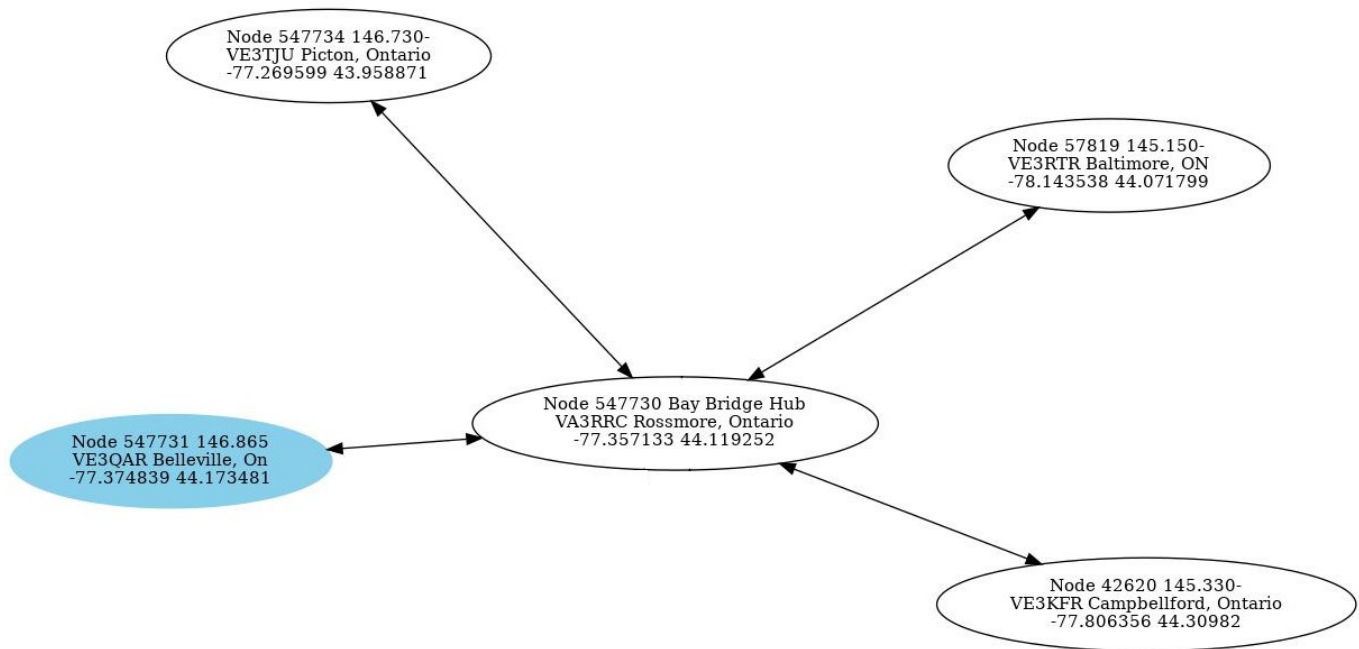

Minutes of QARC Meeting - November 17, 2025

The meeting was brought to order by club President Dave Ackerman VE3OX.

Silent Key: A moment of silence for **Don Dulmage VE3LYX** who passed away peacefully on Oct 29th and will be missed by many members and friends.

Dave VE3OX welcomed attendees.

A **motion** to accept the **Minutes** as published in the newsletter of the last meeting was made by Sean VA3BZC and seconded Dennis VA3DWK . The **motion was carried**.

A **motion** to accept the **Treasurers report** was made by Attila VE3KAS and seconded Don VE3UHO . The **motion was carried**.

Member Brad VA3CBU who attended a public meeting on proposed installation of **Over the Horizon Radar** site in Ontario has consulted with RAC who are now aware and researching.

Guest speaker Belleville Fire Prevention Officer **Richard Quick** spoke to the membership about Lithium Ion battery safety and other topics.. among many topics, he had these important tips -

Use proper equipment: Always use the charger that came with your device or a reputable, certified third-party charger. Incompatible chargers can cause issues.

Charge on a hard, flat surface: Never charge devices on soft surfaces like a bed, couch, or carpet, as they can trap heat. Avoid charging near exits, windows, or where you sleep.
Unplug when fully charged - Modern devices have safeguards, but it is still best practice to unplug once fully charged.

Allow for cooling - Let a battery cool down after use before recharging and after charging before using again.

Monitor for damage - If a battery becomes excessively hot, smells strange, or shows signs of swelling, bulging, or leaking, stop using it immediately.

Safe storage and handling - Store in a cool, dry place: Avoid storing batteries in direct sunlight or hot/cold cars.

Protect from physical damage: Do not throw, puncture, or drop batteries, as physical damage can lead to internal shorts and fires

More Minutes - (cont'd)

Keep away from metal: Store batteries away from anything that can cause a short circuit, such as coins, keys, or tools.

Keep out of reach of children: Keep batteries away from children and pets.

Use protective cases: When transporting spare batteries, keep them in a non-metal, protective case.

Safe disposal: Never put them in household trash: Lithium-ion batteries can cause fires in waste trucks and landfills. Use designated drop-off sites. Take used batteries to special waste drop-off locations or local recycling centers.

Protect terminals: When disposing of loose batteries, cover the terminals with non-conductive tape (like electrical tape) or place each one in a separate plastic bag to prevent them from touching each other.

Richard also mentioned **changes** to the **Fire Code** which will require Carbon Monoxide (CO) detectors on every level of a dwelling that has wood or gas burning appliances; or attached garage, effective **January 1, 2026**.

Members thanked Richard for coming out answering many fire safety questions.

Other Business: Dave VE3OX discussed the **Christmas Dinner** we go to with the Tractor Club. The dinner will be on the 29 November, the cost is 30\$ per person. If you would like to go, sign up is with Dave, with a cutoff date of the 23 November, this year beef is on the menu with entertainment and door prizes. Dave also has tickets for the Tractor Draw available. Doors open at 2 pm Dinner at 6 pm.

Dave VE3OX and Tim VE3UO met with **Nathan Dudley** the new head of **Hastings County Emergency services**. The services are interested in where QARC can fit into the overall plan during emergencies. Dave and Tim briefed him on the role amateurs played during the 1998 ice storm.. another meeting is planned for the new year.

The **VE3BEL UHF repeater update** by Matt VE3FL the Wires X was shut off and the repeater was placed in dual mode, however after a flurry of activity at first it went back to being mostly silent. The thoughts now are to perhaps change it to a **DMR repeater**. Some members very familiar with DMR will be consulted about the feasibility of doing this ... this subject is still a work in progress .. stay tuned!
